

ORDINANCE 06-10-19A.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Mantua, Utah, has adopted and passed the Ordinances of the Town of Mantua, which Code continues in full force and effect, as it has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 98-5-7, Section 13-256(a)(4), entitled Restrictions on Certain Dog Breeds, mandates certain requirements upon owners of certain breeds of dogs which by their unique hereditary characteristics have a propensity to be vicious; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Mantua desires to provide more liability protection to the Town and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Mantua has determined that it would be in the best interest of and promote the welfare of its residents if said Section 13-256(a)(4) was amended as provided in this Ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Council of the Town of Mantua, Utah hereby adopts, passes and publishes the following:

ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 13-256(a)(4) OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF MANTUA.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Mantua, Utah as follows:

1. Ordinance No. 98-5-7, Section 13-256(a)(4) of the Code of Revised Ordinances of The Town of Mantua is hereby amended to read as follows:

13-256(a)(4). RESTRICTIONS ON CERTAIN DOG BREEDS.

- a. HEREDITARY CHARACTERISTICS. There are certain breeds of dogs which by their unique hereditary characteristics, owner training and instruction, or through mistreatment have a propensity to be vicious. These breeds include, but are not limited to, the Bull Terrier, the American Staffordshire Terrier, Staffordshire Terrier, Staffordshire Bull Terrier, American Pit Bull Terrier, Tosa, Sharpei, Rotweiler, and Doberman Pincer.

The dogs identified under this section:



(4) Must, at the time of licensing, provide proof of a fully paid homeowners or rental insurance policy containing a personal liability clause in the amount of \$1,000,000.00 (one million dollars), that cannot be canceled without *written* notification to the Town.
