

ORDINANCE NO. 91- 004

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 87-001
PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING AND CONTROL OF DOGS,
SETTING OF RULES AND REGULATIONS CONCERNING THE SAME, AND
FIXING RATES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF MANTUA TOWN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 15: Impounding and Reclaiming Dogs running at large

B. The owner or keeper of any dog so impounded may reclaim the dog within the period of impoundment by paying the Town of Mantua all fees incurred in the control and care of said animal.

The owner of any dog that is humanely disposed of by the Box Elder County or Brigham City Animal Shelter shall be required to pay the current fee as set by these establishments.

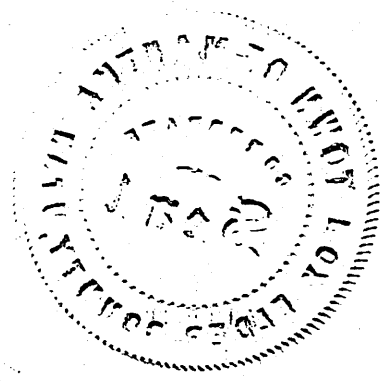
