

ORDINANCE # 17-04-07

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF TEMPORARY BUSINESS LICENCES AND TEMPORARY USE PERMITS.

WHEREAS, The Mantua Town Council determines that it is in the best interest of the residents of the community to allow vendors the opportunity to place items for sale during times of town celebrations or other special events on a limited and temporary basis.

WHEREAS, The Mantua Town Council has researched the policies and permit structure in other communities and wishes to adopt similar regulations.

THEREFORE, in the best interest of the Town of Mantua let the following be ordained.

1. Any person, vendor, firm or other business wishing to offer items for sale during a special event or community celebration shall first apply to the Town Offices for a Temporary Business License. The Town reserves the right to deny such license to any person, vendor, firm or other business if it be determined that such merchandize could be harmful, contraband, or offensive to the standards of the community.
2. Any persons requiring said license who sells or attempts to offer for sale any merchandize without first obtaining a Temporary Business License shall be in violation of an infraction and be subject to a fine of not less than \$200.
3. The Town of Mantua shall also require any person, firm, group or organization wishing to sponsor or hold any event which would, in the determination of the Mayor, Chief of Police or Public Works Director, create a substantial burden on the infrastructure, manpower or any other community services, to apply for a Temporary Use Permit.
4. Persons desiring to hold such events shall first make application to the Town Offices for a Temporary Use Permit. Mantua Town reserves the right to deny any application which it feels would pose an undue burden on the resources of the Town or which might prove harmful or offensive to the community standards.
5. Any persons requiring a Temporary Use Permit and failing to obtain such permit shall be guilt of an infraction and be subject to a fine of not less than \$500.
6. In no case shall a Temporary Business License be issued to any persons selling items 'door to door' or selling liquor or any other alcoholic beverages.

All required forms, fees, and various requirements relating to the issuance of the Temporary Business Licenses, or Temporary Use Permits may be adjusted and changed from time to time as seems necessary

by the office staff and with consent of the Town Council. Fees shall be posted in the Mantua Town Fee Schedule.


This ordinance being passed on this 20 Day of April 2017.

Ordinance# 17-04-07 shall become effective upon proper posting as required by Utah State Law.
