

ORDINANCE No.

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING SOLICITORS, PEDDLERS, HAWKERS, ITINERANT MERCHANTS OR TRANSIENT VENDORS OF MERCHANDISE IN THE TOWN OF MANTUA, UTAH: DECLARING TO BE A NUISANCE FOR THOSE ENGAGING IN SUCH PERSUITS TO GO IN OR UPON PRIVATE RESIDENCES WITHOUT HAVING BEEN REQUESTED OR INVITED TO DO SO, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF: AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF MANTUA, UTAH, as follows:

Section 1: The practice of going in and upon private residences in Mantua Town, Utah, by solicitors, peddlers, hawkers, itinerant merchants or transient vendors of merchandise, not having been requested or invited so to do by the owner or owners, occupant or occupants of said private residences for the purpose of soliciting orders for the sale of goods, wares and merchandise and/or disposing of and/or peddling or hawking the same is declared to be a nuisance and punishable as such nuisance as a misdemeanor.

Section 2: Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined not more than \$299.00 or imprisoned more than six months or both fined and imprisoned in the discretion of the court.

Section 3: The provisions of this ordinance shall not apply to the sale, or soliciting of order for the sale of milk, dairy products, vegetables, poultry, eggs and other farm and garden produce.

Section 4: Any ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are herewith and hereby repealed.

Section 5: That it is the opinion of the Town Board of Mantua, that it is necessary to the health, peace, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Town of Mantua, that this ordinance take effect upon its first posting and it is hereby ordered that this ordinance shall take effect upon its first passage and posting.
